Respondents were first asked whether they have a disability and were then asked to mark one or more categories describing the disability or disabilities (blind/visually impaired, deaf/hard of hearing, physical/orthopedic disability, learning/cognitive disability, vocal/speech disability, or other disability). Data for 2010 were not included in table because the questions about disability were revised at that time.
