NOTES: Institutions with the same number of doctorate recipients are listed alphabetically. Data in this table differ from doctoral degree data in other tables and figures in this report that are based on NSF Survey of Earned Doctorates (SED). SED data are for research doctorates only. Greatest differences are in psychology. Before 2008 National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) used two doctoral degree categories: doctor's and first-professional. In 2008 and 2009 NCES allowed optional reporting in three new doctoral degree categories: doctor's-research/scholarship, doctor's-professional practice, and doctor's-other. In 2010 NCES required institutions to use only the three new doctoral degree categories. With new reporting system, degrees formerly classified as first-professional (e.g., MDs and JDs) can be reported as doctoral degrees, most often as doctor's-professional practice. In this table data for 2008 and 2009 include only doctorates reported under the old doctor's degree category plus those reported as doctor's-research/scholarship. Data for 2010 include only doctorates reported as doctor's-research/scholarship.
